<p>Does your child have any of the following symptoms that are <i>not</i> caused by another condition?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fever (100.4°F or higher) or chills</li> <li>Cough</li> <li>Difficulty breathing</li> <li>Unusually tired</li> <li>Muscle or body aches</li> <li>Headache</li> <li>Recent loss of taste or smell</li> <li>Sore throat</li> <li>Stuffy or runny nose</li> <li>Nausea or vomiting</li> <li>Diarrhea or abdominal pain</li> </ul>	<p>Has your student had any of the above symptoms in the past 3 days?</p> <p>Has your child been in close contact with anyone with confirmed COVID-19?</p> <p>Has your child had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 10 days?</p> <p>Within the past 14 days, has a public health or medical professional told you to self-monitor, self-isolate, or self-quarantine your child because of concerns about COVID-19 infection?</p>

If you answer **YES** to *any* of the questions, please keep your child home from school.

Please make sure someone is available by phone every day in case we have a question or concern at school. If your child is sick, he/she will need to go home right away.
